Willow Oaks Country Club Richmond, Virginia 23238

Since its opening in 1957, the 6730-yard Willow Oaks Golf Course has been recognized as one of Virginia’s superior layouts. W.F. Gordon and Son designed the par 72 course to take advantage of its location beside the scenic James River. Bermuda grass tees and a continuous cart path make the course well-suited to remain open year-round for walkers and riders alike. Small wonder the State Open of Virginia has been played here fifteen times.

Directions to Willow Oaks Country Club I-95 South from Washington, D.C.

Take Exit 79 for 195 South–Powhite Parkway exit. Follow 195 South across James River to the first exit–Forest Hill Ave. Bear right after passing through the 70¢ toll onto Forest Hill Ave. Travel 100 yards to entrance on the right.

I-95 North from Petersburg, VA

Take Chippenham Parkway (150 North–Falling Creek exit) to Forest Hill Ave. East exit. Travel east on Forest Hill Ave. approximately 1 mile to entrance on the left. If you cross the railroad tracks you have gone too far.

I-64 East from Charlottesville, VA

Take 195 South–Powhite Parkway exit. Follow 195 south across James River to the first exit–Forest Hill Ave. Bear right after passing through the 70¢ toll onto Forest Hill Ave. Travel 100 yards to entrance on the right.

I-64 West from Williamsburg, VA

Take I-64 West to Richmond. Follow signs to I-95 North/I-64 West (stay in far right lane). Travel I-95 North approximately 1 mile and exit I-95 for Powhite Parkway (195 South) and I-64 West. Exit to the left to 195 South. Follow 195 South to the first exit across the James River–Forest Hill Ave. Bear right after passing through the 70¢ toll onto Forest Hill Avenue. Travel 100 yards to entrance on the right.
