### Farmington Country Club Charlottesville, Virginia 22901

Since it's opening in 1927, Farmington Country Club has been considered one of the most challenging courses in Virginia. This par 70, 6700 yd. eighteen-hole layout by Fred Findlay runs along small valleys, across numerous "branches" and ravines, over two ponds and between tall trees. Throughout the course, you will enjoy extraordinary views of the Blue Ridge Mountains.

#### Directions to Farmington Country Club

**From Richmond, Virginia:** Take Interstate I-64 West to Charlottesville. Take exit 118-B (Route 29 North). Go 1.5 miles to Route 250 West (2nd exit). Turn left and follow 250 West towards Ivy for approximately 1 mile. At the 3rd traffic light turn right onto Farmington Drive. The Club is about 1 mile on the left.

**From Washington D.C.:** Take I-495 to I-66 West. Take I-66 past Manassas to Gainesville. Take the Route 29 South (Gainesville Exit) towards Charlottesville and Culpeper. Follow 29 South for approximately 80 miles to Charlottesville. Take the Lynchburg, VA exit onto the Route 250/29 South Bypass and travel to the 2nd exit (Ivy, Crozet, Local Traffic Only). Turn right onto Rt. 250 West at the traffic light. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right at the first traffic light onto Farmington Drive. The Club is about 1 mile on the left.

**From Roanoke, Virginia:** Take I-81 North to I-64 East towards Charlottesville. Take exit 118-B (Route 29 North). Go 1.5 miles to Route 250 West (2nd exit). Turn left and follow 250 West towards Ivy for approximately 1 mile. At the 3rd traffic light turn right onto Farmington Drive. The Club is about 1 mile on the left.
